
# Report on Shivam Formation Meet

Guided by the teachers the students collected in the play ground – the allotted safe zone. Following all the safety measures, the entire senior and middle wing building was successfully cleared within a span of 3 minutes and 5 minutes respectively.

The drill was organized to check the readiness of the school to face any such emergency during any natural calamity and also to make the students and staff aware about the Fire Fighting rescue operation and its procedure. These mock drills help in meeting the challenges in adverse situations and in coping with the situation during the time of natural and man-made disaster.

**Fire Safety Demonstration:** The fire safety demonstration included practical tips on how to prevent fires, how to safely evacuate a building in case of a fire, and how to properly use fire extinguishers.

It was delivered on 8th August, 2024 at Assembly Hall for the students of Grade-1 to 7. The points were discussed to create awareness to all the students and teachers and discussed different kinds of fire and the causes of their occurrences and how to use fire extinguishers.
